But, guess what, God protected it and they found it. That just doesn't happen by chance, especially in Europe. He protected the team from illness while on the trip – that just doesn't happen. We showed the movie "Evan Almighty" for the first three nights of camp with the purpose of doing an "ARK" on Friday morning. If you have seen the movie, ARK means "Act of Random Kindness". The team had planned on allowing the older group, which ended up being all girls, to take the evangelism bracelets with the card explaining their colors and a New Testament Bible to the nearby Village to give away to random people. The girls came alive and shared Christ to strangers. This is something that is just not done in Romania – at least in this area! They were so excited and they even shared their experiences that evening during worship time. Even after they went home they were changed. This past Sunday, Pastor Florin allowed them to share what camp meant to them and he was so blessed to hear their stories of how it has changed their lives for eternity. Even their parents were in awe of how the children had changed. As Lydia (Pastor Florin's wife) said, this camp will be something that these children will never ever forget – they wanted it to go on for a couple more weeks it was so special for them.
